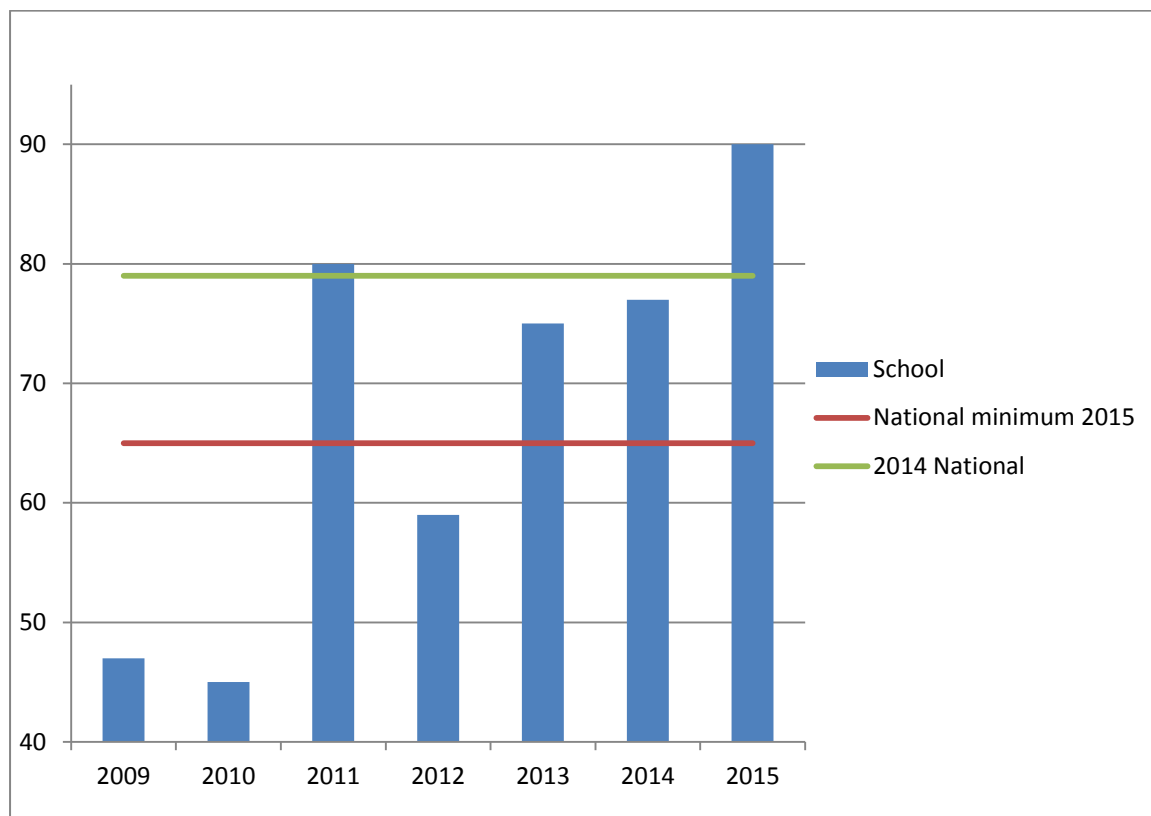

English and Maths Level 4+ Combined

Level 4 is the nationally expected level for a child at the end of year 6. The national minimum for schools last year was for at least 65% of year 6 children to reach this level (65% is indicated by the red line below). The 2014 national figure is shown by the green line.



English

In 2014, three separate aspects of 'English' were assessed and reported upon: reading, writing and 'SPaG' (spelling, punctuation and grammar). This is the third year of the SPaG assessment taking place at KS2. Currently, the SPaG results are not incorporated in the 'overall' measure of combined performance. The table below shows the percentage of children attaining at each level in the three aspects (a comparison with the last 3 years of results is given).

Maths

2 Levels Progress

2 levels progress is the nationally expected level of progress from Key Stage 1 to Key Stage 2. The table below shows the percentage of children making 2 levels progress in reading, writing and maths at Kemsley Primary Academy. The 2012 and 2013 figures are given as a comparison along with the national figures for 2013.
