e Safety = e behaviour



*As Technology continues to change the way we live and work each day. To help us use it, to its full potential we must understand the positive and negative impacts of its use.*

*e Safety is not about technology it is in fact about behaviour - the behaviour of the user and the behaviour of others online.*

# Why and what do we do in school?



*e Safety is monitored as part of the OFSTED Framework through the Safeguarding Children strand, however, there is every possibility schools can have an e Safety inspection.*

*Throughout their visit they would expect to see;*

- Staff who have been trained to help improve their eSafety knowledge and expertise.
- The school working with families to help their children to be safe responsible users of technology
- Regularly reviewed and developed school eSafety policies and procedures
- Provide an age appropriate, relevant and wide-ranging eSafety curriculum and be able to demonstrate the impact this has had upon pupil behaviour

Each year we start off with an E Safety assembly which shares CEOP (Children's Exploitation and Online Protection) video for both Years 1,2 ,3 and 4 and another for years 5 and 6.

These are repeated each year, with no apologies – the repetition ensures the children can build on a strengthening message about their own and others' behaviour online.

# Before we use the internet in school....



In years 1,2,3,4 use of the internet is mostly via provided links, there are some opportunities for the children to use child safe search engines.

*We know that no search engine is ever 100% safe, even with our schools filtering systems but as much as possible we educate the children to use the internet responsibly and so below are some links to some “safer” search engines:*

In years 5 and 6, children are supported to use ‘Google’ to search through the schools filtering system and are taught what to do should their be any site, image or content that makes them feel uncomfortable.

1. Close the lid of laptop.
2. Call an adult over.
3. The adult will take the address and email for this to be filtered/blocked.

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# E Safety.... not just the children



It is important to bare in mind that the staff at school are as vulnerable as the children. All staff sign up to the ' ICT acceptable use Policy' which includes;

- teaching staff to use secured drives to transfer data between home and school
- all data is stored and kept in accordance with the Data Protection Act 1988
- no information, data or media is kept on personal devices
- all incidents of concern regarding children's online safety are to be reported to the Designated Child Protection Coordinator
- no attempt will be made to bypass any filtering and/or security systems put in place by the school
- any electronic communications with pupils, parents/carers and other professionals will only take place via work approved communication channels e.g. via a school provided email address or telephone number. Any pre-existing relationships which may compromise this will be discussed with the Senior Leadership team.
- will not create, transmit, display, publish or forward any material that is likely to harass, cause offence, inconvenience or needless anxiety to any other person, or anything which could bring my professional role, the school, or REACH2, into disrepute.
- will promote e-Safety with the pupils in my care and will help them to develop a responsible attitude to safety online, system use and to the content they access or create.



# E Safety .... not just the internet



e Safety is all about e-communication, this was once predominantly the internet, now for the children who are in Ks2 eSafety and eBehaviour is required for.....

- apps – instagram, Snapchat, facebook, whatsapp, messengers, GooglePlus, Kick, Twitter to name but a few – this list grows daily!
- mobile telephones
- games consoles
- tablets
- interactive TV services
- laptops and computers.

Many of these apps have parental control help facilities so you can see how to support your child in safely accessing and using the technology.

*Links to the parents support sites will be available for the most popular apps used by children in school via the school website.*

# What can we do together?



- Talk to your child/ren about what they are doing – do not feel embarrassed you haven't a clue what it is. Just listen!
- Ensure as much as possible devices are used in communal areas – you will notice if you child begins to look uncomfortable whilst online.
- Display the visual reminders used at school this is further reinforcement for the e Behaviour message – share the CEOP videos too!
- If there are topics/apps you would like to know more about then please contact the school, you will not be alone and sessions can be held for you to gain more understanding.
